

STRATEGY 1: NOTE MAKING

The Maltese Islands started to form around 30 to 25 million years ago when sediment and fossils were deposited on the bottom of the sea. The different rock layers resulted from different environments and geological times in which the sediments and fossils were deposited. Around 10 million years ago, these rock layers rose to the surface due to African plate and the Eurasian plate moving towards each other causing the sediment in between to uplift. Therefore, all of the Maltese rock types are sedimentary.
